GIVING CAMPAIGN

Well, here we are at the end of the 2025 Fall season. We hope all is well with you and your families this season. The SBCA Annual Board Meeting was held on October 25. Our new initiative is to replace the existing deteriorating fence along the cemetery's property lines with a new style lower maintenance type of fence. This is a Minnesota cemetery after all with trees, wind, snow, rain, attacking the existing fence. Since 2020, with the hard work of a few, utilizing donated and pieced lumber have fused broken rails and replaced deteriorated posts initially installed when the fence was new in 2007. Please see the attached pictures for better understanding of the need for new fencing. Since this is a major undertaking and folks may need time to help with cash contributions, we will approach this in 2 phases, with Phase 1 focusing on the north side fence. Our goal for Phase 1 donations is \$2,500 and our target installation date is in Spring 2027.
